Opa! Greek Dance and Culture

In this highly interactive program, children will explore Greek culture and history through traditional music, dance, and storytelling.

They'll have the chance to participate in the iconic Zorba dance, listen to captivating Greek myths and folk songs, and be introduced to authentic instruments such as the Baglama, Tzoura, and Cretan Lyra.



Commedia Dell'Arte

Step into the playful world of classic Italian theatre in this high-energy solo show!

Featuring music, mime, magic, and mayhem, kids meet hilarious characters like Pantalone and Arlecchino while learning about masks, character roles, and circus skills. Packed with laughs and audience participation, this program is perfect for little mischiefs!

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Aboriginal Infusion

Aboriginal Infusion is a highly interactive and engaging introduction to the rich, continuing traditions and cultural aspects of Australia's First Peoples, such as dance, didgeridoo, artefacts and storytelling.

Maloyan Infusion

This interactive workshop introduces participants to Maloya, a traditional Creole music and dance from Réunion Island. Rooted in African, Malagasy, and Indian heritage, Maloya blends rhythmic drumming, call-and-response singing, and expressive dance.



Cool Capoeira

Originating in Brazil as a martial art disguised as dance, Capoeira has UNESCO intangible cultural heritage status. Students will learn acrobatic manoeuvres accompanied by the beautiful sound of the Berimbau musical instrument. Capoeira is for all.



Le Gioie Delle Donne

Le Gioie Delle Donne, The Joys of the Women Italian Choir, sings joyous Italian folk songs with a passion and enthusiasm that is infectious, bring to life the warmth of Italian traditions, fostering connection and joy among audiences.

Bollywood Infusion

Bollywood is an important part of modern Indian culture, referring to the Hindi film industry, and categorised by colourful displays of music, dance, and costume. Participants will learn about the folk and classical origins of the Bollywood dances.



Classical Indian Dance

Immerse your students in the culture of ancient India that is still practised to this day in the workshop. Students will learn some of the symbolic gestures and movements and the stories they tell.



Indonesian Infusion

Indonesian Infusion will take participants on an immersive and interactive journey, showcasing the amazing diversity of the Indonesian community.



Bali in Motion

Bali in Motion provides students with the opportunity to experience a true taste of Balinese cultural activities! Music, dance and the visual arts form a foundation for traditional Balinese life, and myths and legends are incorporated into these arts.





Chinese Martial Arts

Martial arts are art forms dating back more than 4,000 years ago. In Chinese Martial Arts, a high energy educational workshop, participants get to delve into the history and philosophy of martial arts in China.



Chinese Fan Dance

A symbol of beauty and grace, Chinese Fan Dance is a colourful, captivating workshop that will get students moving with their own fans as they learn all about the Chinese Fan Dance and its origins.



Chinese Lantern Dance

An ancient form of folk dance first documented in the Eastern Han Dynasty, Chinese Lantern Dance dates back 2,000 years ago and is used to tell stories and traditions of Chinese Culture.



Chinese Lion Dance

Signifying good fortune, prosperity and longevity, the Chinese Lion Dance is an art form dating back to the 12th century! This workshop will give students an opportunity to see the Lion up close while gaining an insight into one of China's oldest traditions.

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Japanese Infusion

Our presenters bring Japanese culture to life with this beautifully crafted program. They teach children about Japanese culture through the use of songs, games and storytelling.



Taiko Drumming

This traditional and original Japanese music program combines amazing performance and an interactive workshop. Students are introduced to Japanese culture, before the room shakes with the sound of the Taiko drums!



Japanese Ink Painting (Sumi-e)

Japanese ink painting, also known as Sumi-e, guides participants in preparing inks and incorporating different ink tones and brush techniques to create traditional ink paintings.



Japanese Calligraphy (Shodo)

Japanese calligraphy, also known as Shodo, is one of the oldest and most profound traditional art forms in Japan. In this program, an experienced Shodo artist will introduce the history and origins of calligraphy.





Rhythms and Instruments of West Africa

The musical cultures of West Africa are explored through rhythms and songs. Students will be introduced to a range of instruments such as the Djembe, Dun Dun drums, Shekere, Talking drum, Balafon and more!



Mbira of Zimbabwe

The Mbira, sometimes called the 'thumb piano', has been played by the Shona people of Zimbabwe for over a thousand years! The presenter will play the Mbira and sing some traditional songs in the Shona language with the students.



Middle Eastern Belly Dance

Middle Eastern Belly Dance introduces the audience to Arab cultures through stories and movement. Participants get the chance to experience the beautiful, health-promoting movements of this highly expressive dance form.



Journey Through Zimbabwe with Rumb Bee

Join jazz artist Rumb Bee in this immersive workshop that blends voice, dance, and the soulful sounds of the Mbira. Through storytelling and song, she shares her journey of migration and healing.



multicultural all-day or half-day program

Living Culture Tanzania

The creative and cultural industries in Tanzania are on the rise. According to a 2015 United Nations Conference on Trade and Development report, creative goods & services exports from Tanzania have risen from US\$2.46 million in 2003, to US\$69.92 million in 2012. Yet government funding towards these industries is still lacking substantially. The relationships between culture, employment and education, if supported, can help Tanzania's young people secure jobs and survive in the workforce. The Living Culture Program helps address this gap through the private sector.



Living Culture Zanzibar

Our Local Development Coordinator Natalie Denmeade has done extensive research on Zanzibar as the heart of the ancient Silk Road, and her findings have been imparted to the performance team so that they may brainstorm ideas on how to tell the rich story of Zanzibar through music and dance. Storytelling is important to the primarily oral literary culture of Tanzania, also reflected in the nation's growing film industry which has been affectionately dubbed "Swahiliwood".



Living Culture Pakistan

Pakistan has experienced significant liberalisation in the past decade which has helped increase its standing on the international stage, and has encouraged the nation to focus on improving gender equality and the integration of women as productive members of its workforce. Our efforts have largely focused on complementing the country's increased commitment to women's empowerment. The program also resonates with Pakistan's ongoing discourse of cultivating its "soft image".
