Aboriginal Storytelling through Art

Aboriginal Storytelling through Art teaches students traditional symbols for people, the land and animals, and assists them with creating and presenting their own stories.

Aboriginal Infusion

Aboriginal Infusion is a highly interactive and engaging introduction to the rich, continuing traditions and cultural aspects of Australia's First Peoples, such as dance, didgeridoo, artefacts and storytelling.

Didgeridoo Beats and Culture

Didgeridoo, Beats and Culture is the perfect introduction to the world's oldest living culture. The presenter, Ganga, is a descendant of the Palawa people of Tasmania, who fuses this ancient instrument with electronic production and vocals.

Didgeridoo Mindfulness Journey

This program includes didgeridoo playing and a story that travels from Yolgnu country to India to Siberia, ending with a meditation. Dean is endorsed by famous Yolngu knowledge holder Djalu Gurruwiwi to teach didgeridoo for wellness.









Chinese Fan Dance

A symbol of beauty and grace, Chinese Fan Dance is a colourful, captivating workshop that will get students moving with their own fans as they learn all about the Chinese Fan Dance and its origins.

Chinese Lion Dance

Signifying good fortune, prosperity and longevity, the Chinese Lion Dance is an art form dating back to the 12th century! This workshop will give students an opportunity to see the Lion up close while gaining an insight into one of China's oldest traditions.

Chinese Martial Arts

Martial arts are art forms dating back more than 4,000 years ago. In Chinese Martial Arts, a high energy educational workshop, participants get to delve into the history and philosophy of martial arts in China.

ICAP (Intercultural Citizenship Ambassador Program) is a flexible 4- or 8-week program for Years 7–8 that includes interactive, facilitated sessions where students build cultural awareness, empathy, and self-esteem while creating inclusive classrooms.

Participating schools also receive a **free Atlas membership**, giving students access to interactive analytics that highlight their school's cultural diversity.

The 8-week program is available *for free* to limited *government schools* and covers eight \times 60-minute facilitated sessions.
