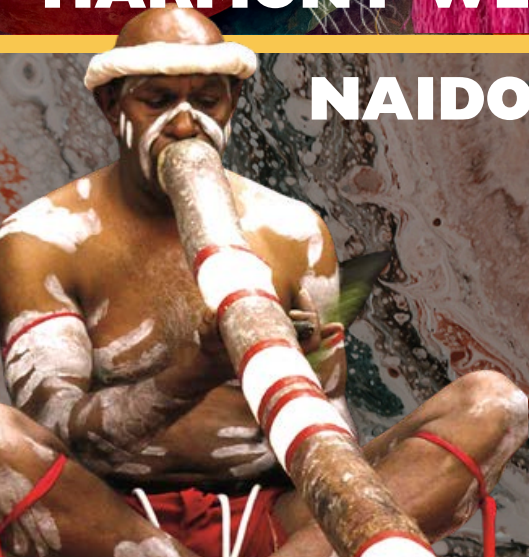

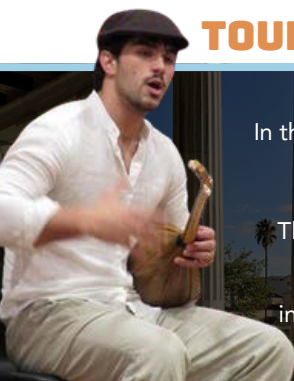

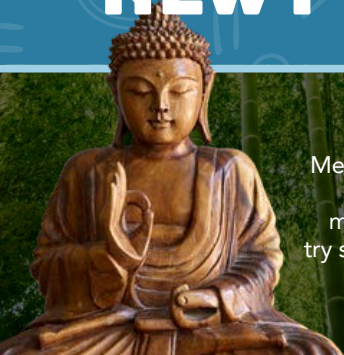

# NEW PROGRAMS & HIGHLIGHTS



## Buddhist Chanting and Mindfulness Through Song

Melanie introduces students to Buddhist chants and songs that support mindfulness and compassion. Students try simple chants, create their own based on shared values, and learn how the Buddha's teachings relate to modern wellbeing and community.

## Sound of Multicultural Australia Trio

This trio blends ancient melodies with African rhythms to create a sound found only in Australia. Uygu, a world-renowned musician; Yaw, a Ghanaian elder-percussionist; and Richard bring their cultures together, sharing their heritage through engaging performances and collaborative musical exchange.



## Dancing around India

Dancing Around India immerses students in the rich cultural diversity of India. They explore folk dances from North, South, East, and West, learn each dance's cultural significance through festivals, food, and landmarks, and conclude by performing in costume.



## Carribean Soul

As part of the tradition of the Moon Festival, participants will be invited to decorate Chinese lanterns adorned with traditional patterns. Decorating the lanterns connects participants with the cultural significance of the festival.



## Chinese Lion Dance

Asia | Dance, Martial Arts

Signifying good fortune, prosperity and longevity, the Chinese Lion Dance is an art form dating back to the 12th century! This workshop will give students an opportunity to see the Lion up close.



## Vietnamese Classical Music

The presenter will introduce learners to the T'rung (ancient Vietnamese bamboo xylophone) and an assortment of other traditional instruments through performance, cultural stories, and interactivity!



## Access to Assyria

Originating in Brazil as a martial art disguised as dance, Capoeira has UNESCO intangible cultural heritage status. Students will learn acrobatic manoeuvres accompanied by the beautiful sound of the Berimbau musical instrument. Capoeira is for all.



## Latin American Dance

South America | Dance

Explore the vibrant world of Latin American dance through an engaging demonstration of Salsa, Cha-cha-cha, Merengue, Bachata, and Tango. Discover the rich cultural significance of these dances.



## Viva Mexico: A Cultural Journey

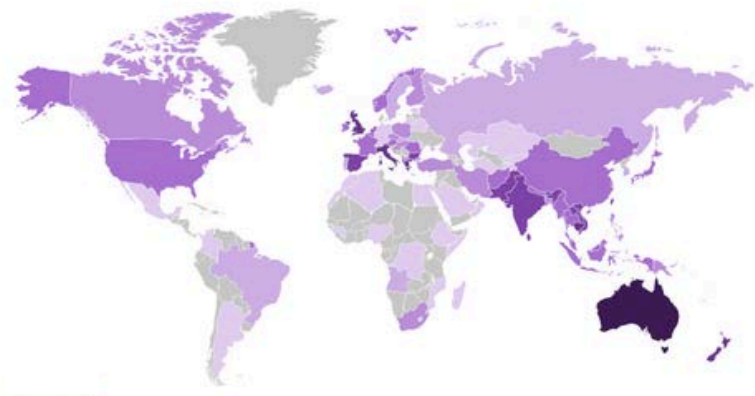
