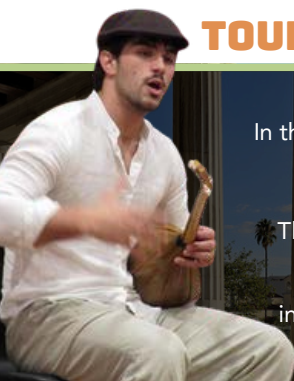

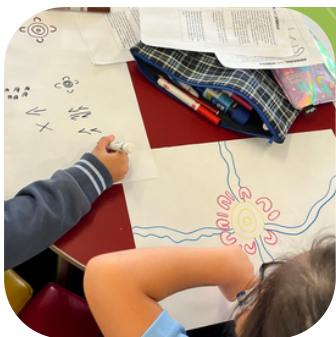


Aboriginal Infusion

Oceania | Music, Storytelling, Dance

Aboriginal Infusion is a highly interactive and engaging introduction to the rich, continuing traditions and cultural aspects of Australia's First Peoples, such as dance, didgeridoo, artefacts and storytelling.

Aboriginal Storytelling through Art

Oceania | Visual Arts, Storytelling

Aboriginal Storytelling through Art teaches students traditional symbols for people, the land and animals, and assists them with creating and presenting their own stories.



Polynesian Infusion

Oceania | Music, Dance, Storytelling

Participants will be transported to the Cook Islands with a traditional dance performance, interactive workshop and fast-paced combination of music, dance, storytelling and craft by performers skilled in drums, ukelele, chanting and more. There is also a hula dancing lesson!



Taiko Drumming

Asia | Music

This traditional and original Japanese music program combines amazing performance and an interactive workshop. Students are introduced to Japanese culture, before the room shakes with the sound of the Taiko drums!



Bollywood Infusion

Asia | Music, Dance

Bollywood is an important part of modern Indian culture, referring to the Hindi film industry, and categorised by colourful displays of music, dance, and costume. Participants will learn about the folk and classical origins of the Bollywood dances.

Nepalese-born Dheeraj is recognised as the foremost Tabla player in Australia. The Tabla is the quintessential percussion instrument of the Indian subcontinent and one of the most complicated drums to play.

Indonesian Infusion will take participants on an immersive and interactive journey, showcasing the amazing diversity of the Indonesian community.

Chinese Drumming

Asia | Music

The earliest known drums in China date back to 4,000 years ago! A performance of rhythm and colour, students will love this hands-on Chinese Drumming workshop as they drum out beats and learn about instruments behind the popular Lion Dance.



Chinese Lion Dance

Asia | Dance, Martial Arts

Signifying good fortune, prosperity and longevity, the Chinese Lion Dance is an art form dating back to the 12th century! This workshop will give students an opportunity to see the Lion up close while gaining an insight into one of China's oldest traditions.



Chinese Martial Arts

Asia | Martial Arts, Wellness

Martial arts are art forms dating back more than 4,000 years ago. In Chinese Martial Arts, a high energy educational workshop, participants get to delve into the history and philosophy of martial arts in China.



Vietnamese Classical Dance

Asia | Dance

Predominantly performed during Lunar New Year and Mid-Autumn Festival, Vietnamese Classical Dance has been an innate part of Vietnamese culture since ancient times; dating as far back as 600BCE!



Cool Capoeira

South America | Martial Arts, Dance

Originating in Brazil as a martial art disguised as dance, Capoeira has UNESCO intangible cultural heritage status. Students will learn acrobatic manoeuvres accompanied by the beautiful sound of the Berimbau musical instrument. Capoeira is for all.



Fire of Flamenco

Multicultural | Dance

Fire of Flamenco incorporates dance, music and singing and has a rich, multicultural history. In this program, students will get to try the accompanying 'Palmas' (clapping) and learn some flamenco dance moves.



Folkloric to Flamenco

Multicultural | Music

Born in France to Sephardic-Moroccan parents, Pauline Maudy teaches Jewish Sephardic songs influenced by Turkey, Greece and the Balkans. Joined by Flamenco guitarist John, students learn Palmas and enjoy a program that can be tailored for Spanish learners.



Beats Around the World

Multicultural | Music

Beats Around the World brings together rhythms from the Middle East, Turkey, the Balkans, Latin America, India and Africa. Students explore global grooves as the presenter shares musical stories and an exciting blend of world percussion in one session.

Vietnamese Classical Music

Asia | Music

The presenter will introduce learners to the T'rung (ancient Vietnamese bamboo xylophone) and an assortment of other traditional instruments through performance, cultural stories, and interactivity!



Thai Infusion

Asia | Dance, Music

Students will experience the enchanting sounds of traditional Thai fiddle like the Saw Duang and Saw U, Bamboo Shaker and Thai Hammered Dulcimer, paired with the grace and beauty of Thai classical dance. Students will get to try elegant dance movements.



Africa Meets the Middle East

Multicultural | Music

From Africa and the Middle East, this program will foster a deeper understanding of how music reflects cultural significance. Students will also explore the connections and distinctions between the musical traditions of Africa and the Middle East.



Rhythms and Instruments of West Africa

Africa | Music

The musical cultures of West Africa are explored through rhythms and songs. Students will be introduced to a range of instruments such as the Djembe, Dun Dun drums, Shekere, Talking drum, Balafon and more!



Middle Eastern Drumming

Middle East | Music

Drumming is an integral part of Middle Eastern cultures and the foundation of Belly Dance. Atman introduces different drums and instruments, explores their origins and influences, and lets students try playing, connecting music, rhythm, and rich cultural traditions.



Hip-Hop Infusion

Multicultural | Dance

In this high-energy interactive program, students will learn about hip-hop and urban dance culture around the world. Using a variety of super-danceable beats that will have all students up and dancing, this is the perfect introduction to the expressive world of hip-hop!



Turkish Rhythms

Europe | Music, Dance

Shaped by Turkic, Byzantine and Ottoman heritage, Turkish music blends influences from Europe, North Africa and the Middle East. Turkish Rhythms introduces students to this culture through Darbuka beats, rhythm skills, and engaging stories and dances.



Japanese Calligraphy (Shodo)

Asia | Visual Arts, Languages

Japanese calligraphy, also known as Shodo, is one of the oldest and most profound traditional art forms in Japan. In this program, an experienced Shodo artist will introduce the history and origins of calligraphy.

The presenter performs traditional songs in the Baganda language, accompanied by the Bakisimba dance and Kidigida rhythms. Students join Joseph in singing and learning the rhythms and songs.



Swedish Dance and Culture

Europe | Dance, Music, Storytelling

Students immerse themselves in Swedish culture through music, dance, and storytelling. Led by Rebecca on the Nyckelharpa, they explore folk songs, traditional dances, and cultural traditions like Midsummer, experiencing the joy of Swedish heritage firsthand.



Balkan Beats

Europe | Music

Embark on a musical journey to Southeastern Europe with an interactive music program suitable for all ages. Students can use whatever percussion instruments they have available – Darabuka, Djembe, Bendir, or simply clap their hands!



Les Chansons Françaises

Europe | Music

In Les Chansons Françaises, Pauline shares stories of her Parisienne childhood in an interactive vocal session with songs that explore intercultural understanding. Students will hear and speak French and end the session learning to waltz!

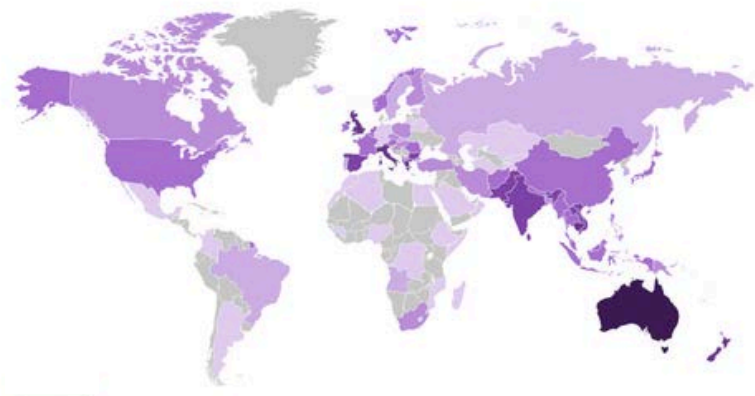
