## Rhythms & Movements of Newar Culture

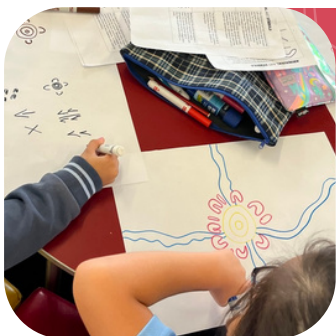
Experience the vibrant sounds and rhythms of Newar culture through traditional music and dance from Nepal.

## Didgeridoo Mindfulness Journey

Oceania | Music, Storytelling

This program includes didgeridoo playing and a story that travels from Yolgnu country to India to Siberia, ending with a meditation. Dean is endorsed by famous Yolngu knowledge holder Djalu Gurruwiwi to teach didgeridoo for wellness.



## Songs of Italia

Europe | Music

Singing in English and Italian, the presenter will take you on a journey, exploring over 600 years of Italian folk music. She delves into how people expressed their lives through song and how these styles differ between region, time, and language.



## Commedia Dell'Arte

Europe | Theatre

Commedia dell'arte began in the 16th century in Italy and its mask theatre became the basis for modern-day comedy and clowning! This solo show introduces the audience to well-known historic Commedia characters.



## Mime Magnifique!

Europe | Theatre

Our Mime Magnifique! program is filled with action, fun and festivities. Taking participants on a journey exploring French culture and history, they will learn the significance of the French art form of mime.

## Music of the Andes

South America | Music

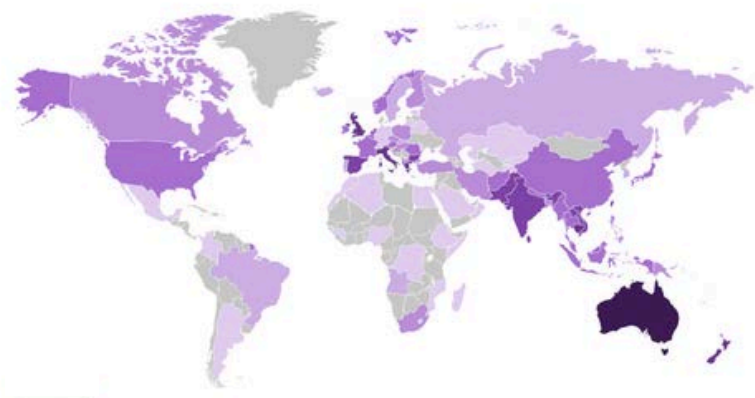

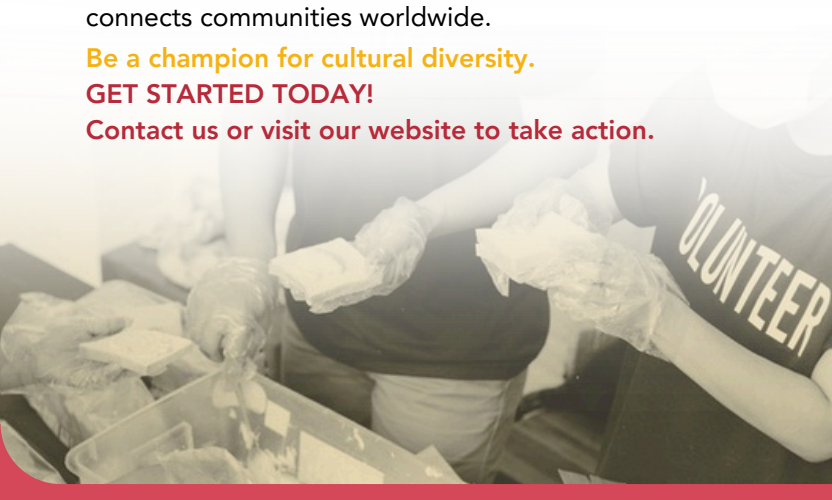
