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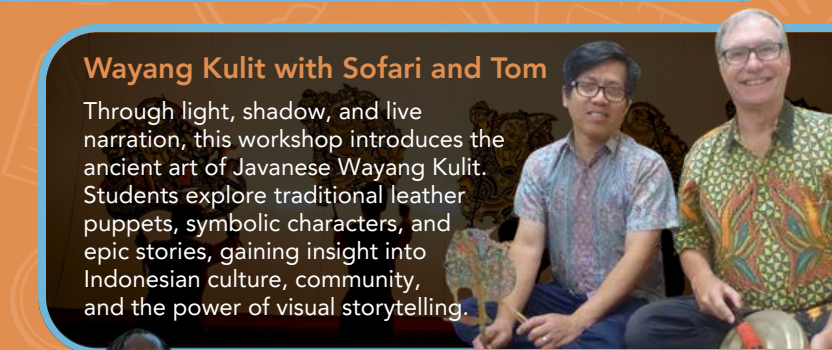


# NEW PROGRAMS & HIGHLIGHTS



## Maloya Infusion

Rooted in the Creole traditions of Réunion Island, this workshop introduces Maloya through rhythm, song, and movement. Students explore call-and-response singing, expressive dance, and traditional instruments, discovering how music carries stories of resilience, identity, and community.



## Wayang Kulit with Sofari and Tom

Through light, shadow, and live narration, this workshop introduces the ancient art of Javanese Wayang Kulit. Students explore traditional leather puppets, symbolic characters, and epic stories, gaining insight into Indonesian culture, community, and the power of visual storytelling.



## Mbira of Zimbabwe

Rooted in Shona spiritual and musical traditions, this workshop introduces the African Mbira, the 'thumb piano' through history, live performance, and participation. Students learn about its cultural significance while accompanying traditional songs with percussion and shared singing.

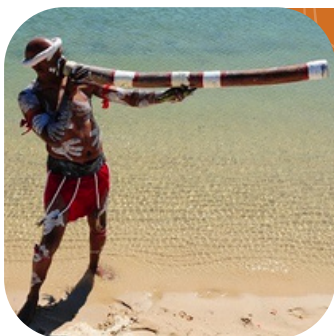


## Le Gioie Delle Donne

## Aboriginal Infusion

Oceania | Music, Storytelling, Dance

Aboriginal Infusion is a highly interactive and engaging introduction to the rich, continuing traditions and cultural aspects of Australia's First Peoples, such as dance, didgeridoo, artefacts and storytelling.

## Maloya Infusion

Africa | Dance, Music, Storytelling

This interactive workshop introduces participants to Maloya, a traditional Creole music and dance from Réunion Island. Rooted in African, Malagasy, and Indian heritage, Maloya blends rhythmic drumming, call-and-response singing, and expressive dance.



## Cool Capoeira

South America | Martial Arts, Dance

Originating in Brazil as a martial art disguised as dance, Capoeira has UNESCO intangible cultural heritage status. Students will learn acrobatic manoeuvres accompanied by the beautiful sound of the Berimbau musical instrument. Capoeira is for all.



## Le Gioie Delle Donne

Europe | Music

Le Gioie Delle Donne, The Joys of the Women Italian Choir, sings joyous Italian folk songs with a passion and enthusiasm that is infectious, bring to life the warmth of Italian traditions, fostering connection and joy among audiences.



## Bollywood Infusion

Asia | Music, Dance

Bollywood is an important part of modern Indian culture, referring to the Hindi film industry, and categorised by colourful displays of music, dance, and costume. Participants will learn about the folk and classical origins of the Bollywood dances.



## Wayang Kulit with Sofari and Tom

Asia | Storytelling, Theatre

Experience the enchanting world of Javanese Wayang Kulit as Tom and Sofari animate hand-carved leather puppets through light and shadow. Students discover Indonesian characters, Hindu epics, and cultural traditions in this captivating blend of storytelling and tradition.

Africa | Music

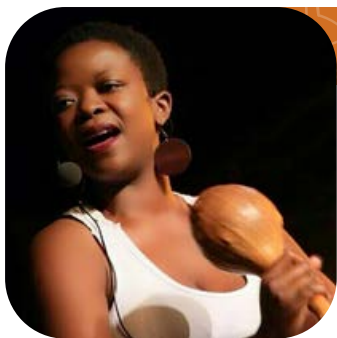

Africa | Music

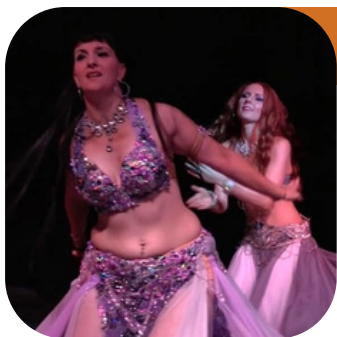

Middle Eastern Belly Dance introduces the audience to Arab cultures through stories and movement. Participants get the chance to experience the beautiful, health-promoting movements of this highly expressive dance form.

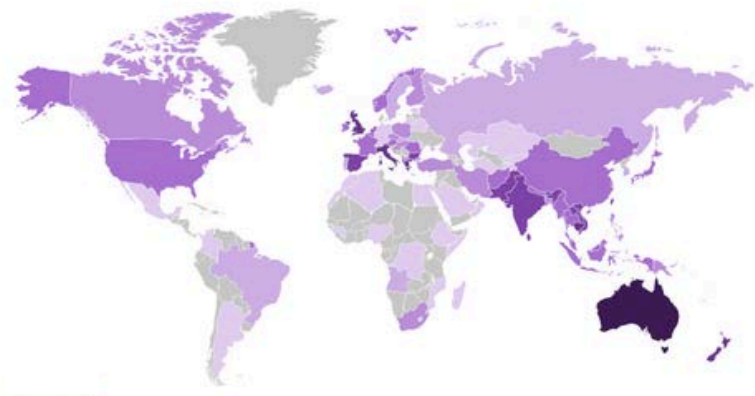
